Alex Eilers, manager of education at the Pink Palace Museum, is returning after two years to Antarctica in November and December to join a research team studying Weddell seals.

The project, called The Cost of a New Fur Coat, will focus on how a seal's life events – such as breeding and molting – might be affected by changes in the climate and environment.

Postcards from the Pole gives you the opportunity to have a postcard sent to you, or anyone you choose, from Antarctica.
