This writing assignment is for grades 3 and up. For grades K-2, students don't need to write down the story, just discuss individual stories as a whole class.

Think of a story you have heard your parents or grandparents tell you. This is a story about a risk hazard – tornado, earthquake, blizzard, hurricane, drought, etc If you cannot think of a story from your parents or grandparents, recall experience of your own. Give as much detail as you can and explain where you were, who else was there, what the weather was like outside, and how it all made you feel.	l an
